Huajian Gao, PhD (Harvard, 1988), is a Xinghua Distinguished University Professor (兴华卓越讲席教授) at Tsinghua University and Walter H. Annenberg Professor Emeritus at Brown University. His research focuses on the understanding of basic principles that control mechanical properties and behaviors of materials in both engineering and biological systems. His honors include the Rodney Hill Medal, Timoshenko Medal, and ASME Medal—the

three highest international awards in his field—and elections to the Chinese Academy of Sciences, U.S. National Academy of Sciences, U.S. National Academy of Engineering, American Academy of Arts and Sciences, U.K. Royal Society, German National Academy of Sciences Leopoldina, and Academia Europaea.
